Motion Text: Member Status – This motion is to amend Article III – Membership, Section 2 to read as follows:

Article III – Membership

Section 2 – Categories of Primary Membership

There shall be seven categories of individual memberships in the association, which shall be respectively, (1) Certified members (Certified Level I, Certified Level II, and Certified Level III), (2) Certified Lifetime Members, (3) Registered Members, (4) Alumni Members, (5) Honorary Members, and (6) Affiliate Members.

- (a) **Certified Instructors:** Members of the Corporation who hold current Level I, II, or III certifications from ASEA-C shall be considered “Certified Instructors”.
- (b) **Certified Lifetime Members:** The Board of Directors may in its discretion grant the status of “Certified Lifetime Member” to persons who are or were active members of ASEA-C. Certified Lifetime Members shall not be required to pay dues and are exempt from the requirements of maintaining education credit.
- (c) **Registered Member:** An instructor who is a member in good standing of both the national and divisional associations but is not certified by ASEA-C. This member may, but is not required, to attend those education events which do not require certification. This member is not eligible to vote or hold office.

- (d) **Alumni:** An ASEA-C Certified Level I, II or III member for ten (10) years who wishes to discontinue teaching, but who desires to remain affiliated with ASEA-C, may request status as an “Alumnus” by application to the Board of Directors. Such Alumni are not required to maintain education credit. However, such Alumni may attend ASEA-C functions and shall be entitled to receive all correspondence and literature that ASEA publishes to its general membership. Members who are granted Alumni status shall continue to pay all dues.

An Alumnus may apply to ASEA-C for reinstatement as an active member. Reinstatement may be granted upon satisfaction of such requirements as the Board of Directors may establish.

- (e) **Honorary Member:** The Board of Directors may select persons who are not members of ASEA-C to be given “Honorary Member” status. Any non-member who has rendered outstanding service to ASEA-C or to the advancement of snow sports instruction shall be eligible for recognition as an Honorary Member of ASEA-C. Honorary Members shall not be required to pay dues but shall pay all other fees associated with the Honorary Member’s participation in events and activities. Honorary Members have no voting rights, are not eligible to hold office, and are not eligible to obtain or maintain certifications.

- (f) **Affiliate Members:** The Board of Directors may select any person or corporation interested in supporting and promoting snow sports, snow sports instruction, and the professional snow sports teacher is eligible for Affiliate Membership. Affiliate Members have no voting rights and are not eligible to hold office.
